ANNOUNCEMENTS & REMINDERS



- Please remember to bring your child's updated vaccine records after routine visits. We are auditing our children's files and ensuring we have all those on record.
- All children who are four years of age must have a vision and hearing test completed and on file with the facility.
- Please ensure your child's emergency contact information is up-to-date in our system. It's vital for the safety of all our students.
- Friendly reminder to inform the school if your child has any new allergies or health concerns that we should be aware of.
- If your child has been ill, they must be symptom-free without medication for 24 hours before returning to school.
- Parents, please remember to sign in your children in and out each day to ensure their safety and help.
- As a reminder, we are a nut-free facility. Please ensure that all snacks and lunches provided from home do not contain nuts or nut products.
- We encourage healthy eating habits. Consider including fruits, vegetables, and whole grains in your child's lunch.
- Each class will be creating a Family Tree project, and we need your help! Please bring a family photo, no larger than 5x7, to your teacher by Friday, September 6th. Your photo will help bring the project to life and celebrate our family connections.
- Our drop-off time is no later than 9:00 a.m. Morning circle and meeting time start promptly at 9:30 a.m. Please let the front office know if you will be late for a doctor's appointment.
- All medications must be dropped off at the front office and signed in. Only administrative staff are authorized to administer medication.
- If you plan to celebrate your child's birthday at school, please coordinate with the classroom teacher one week in advance. Remember, due to allergy concerns, all treats must be store-bought and sealed.
- Remember to label your child's (children's) belongings as much as possible! Jackets, backpacks, water bottles, lunch boxes, clothing etc.
- A reminder that as the season changes, we will need to ensure that extra clothing in cubbies matches the weather and is labeled with your child's name.
- For their safety, please make sure your child is wearing closed-toed shoes.
